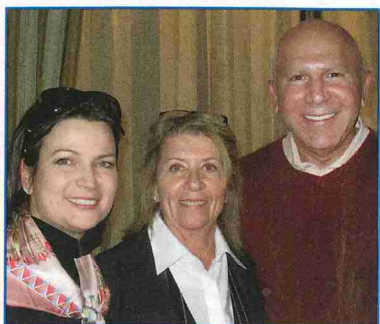

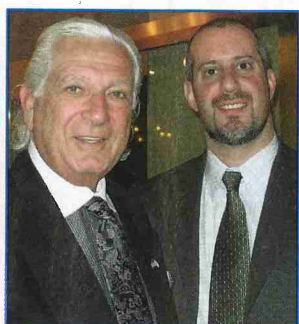
Human Rights, for renewal of their license.

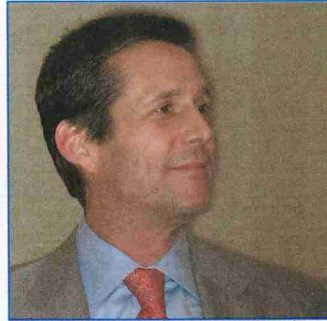
